<u>Comments</u> : Elevated bilirubin without abnormal liver enzyme values or indication of hemolysis (no increased LDH, no decreased haptoglobin). Bilirubin is often elevated in patients suffering from gallstones. Consider also Gilbert's syndrome (mild congenital conjugation disorder, incidence in the general population: 6%). This isolated bilirubin elevation is clinically insignificant, although in a few cases minor complaints may appear. Bilirubin increases with stress, fasting, etc. A DNA-test is possible, but there is seldom an indication for this.
